

ACTIVITY: LISTEN CLOSELY

How can we move forward together?

This activity supports exploration of the key themes raised in the book and positive action towards inclusion.

Read *Listen*. Take time to look slowly at each page, explore the text and detailed illustrations with students.

Invite students (depending on age) to consider the following questions,

- What values does this book speak to?
- Discuss

Read

- Who is this book speaking about?
- Who is this book trying to speak to?
- What action can we take?

Connect

In pairs or triads, invite students to consider what we can do together to move forward. Who are some of the people we can listen to and learn from in our community? Think about local elders, knowledge holders, those who can help us better care for land and waterways and animals. Encourage students to fill in the letters of LISTEN with people, symbols, ideas and key words.
