Help students to consider features that make them special and unique. Invite students to connect and celebrate each other by completing this <u>template</u>. MEEP! Is a beautiful picture book by Andy which celebrates difference. <u>Read online with</u> <u>students</u>

Encourage students to consider how they can look after their mental and physical wellbeing. Create a list of mindfulness activities.


As a class discuss some of the strategies students can use when faced with a tricky decision. Invite students to draw a portrait of themselves holding a balloon filled with their strategies.



Encourage students to consider decisions which are inside and outside their control using the <u>Circles of</u> <u>Control</u> resource. Invite students to delve deeper into Andy's book *MEEP* and put themselves into the story. Using the <u>Connections</u> resource, support students to relate the book back to their own lives. Support students to consider their own personal values. Construct them into a <u>personal values</u> <u>statement</u> to be displayed in the classroom.









## Circles of Control

When faced with a decision, always remember there are things you can and cannot control. Use the template to help you figure out which is which.





