This year at Enlighten we're asking you to check your relationship status with democracy. Join us for a family-friendly, fun night out. If you've never been to MoAD before, now is the perfect time to come inside, explore Old Parliament House and get to know democracy a little better," Ms Wolgamot said.

"Enlighten is one of our favourite events and MoAD is the place to be. It's a chance for visitors to engage in activities that connect with democracy in unexpected ways."

Whether you're flying solo, on a first date, or enjoying a night out with friends, there's something for everyone:

- **Dancing in King's Hall** twirl and two-step through history in one of Australia's most historic venues with line dancing group, Saddle Club.
- **Karaoke love anthems** belt out classic ballads in the very halls where political careers were made (and broken!).
- **DIY friendship bracelet station** create a keepsake to celebrate democracy, friendship, and maybe even a new spark.

- **Get to know democracy** We'll set you up on a 'date with democracy', choose one of five unique adventures around the building.
- Food and drinks at the exclusive Members' Bar and Dining Rooms open to museum visitors only during Enlighten, offering a perfect setting to debrief after a night of fun.

No matter if you're a history buff, a political junkie, hopeless romantic or simply looking for a unique night out, a *Date with Democracy* at Old Parliament House is an unmissable experience.
